WHAT IS THE WASHINGTON COUNTY RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE DECAL PROGRAM?

Effective on , residents of Washington County, Virginia, that wish to dispose of household trash at any of the County's Convenience Stations or the Landfill, must obtain and display a County Residential Vehicle Decal to use the facilities.

- There is no additional cost to the taxpayer for the County Decal.
- Washington County residents and real property owners may obtain County Decals through the <u>Washington County's Office of the County Administrator</u>, <u>mail-in application</u>, <u>online application</u> <u>form</u>, or <u>in person</u>.
- The County Administrator's Office personnel will verify each request in order to issue the County
 Decal(s) to a resident or real property owner of Washington County. Residents must show their
 current driver's license and vehicle registration for which they are requesting an additional or new
 vehicle decal.
- The decal is not transferable and may be revoked if used in violation of the Solid Waste Department rules/regulations.
- The decal may not be given to, or shared with non-County residents.
- One (1) County Decal will be issued every three (3) years with a maximum total of two (2) for personal vehicles that the resident can request to be used at all County-owned Solid Waste facilities. One decal will be mailed with the resident's tax billing (every three (3) years) with additional decals available at the County Administrator's Office.
- County Decals are not available for commercial business users.
- County Decals do not relieve the customer of any disposal fees that may be applicable.
- County staff reserves the right to ask for other identification/proof of residency.
- The County Decal must be affixed to the right side of the official inspection sticker (on the driver's side) when viewed through the windshield from inside the vehicle. The side edge adjacent to the disposal decal shall not be more than ¼ inch from the edge of the official inspection sticker (per the Code of Virginia: 19VAC30-40-30 Placement).
